We encourage manuscripts critically analyzing issues of racism, discrimination, and health inequities with a special interest in manuscripts focusing on the following priority areas:

- Novel research methodologies and methods to study racism, discrimination, and health inequities
 - among people and communities at risk for or living with HIV
 - sexual and gender minorities
- Theoretical approaches, models, and interventions to combat racism and discrimination
- Intersections between the social contributors of health, racism, and discrimination
- Policy issues contributing to inequities in treatment and outcomes among PLWH and sexual and gender minorities
- Deconstructing “race” as a research variable
- Approaches to addressing implicit bias in health care encounters
- Educational innovations and teaching-learning strategies to explore racism and discrimination among health profession’s learners
- Translational and implementation science approaches to addressing racism, discrimination, microaggressions, and intersectional stigma
