Our program is one of **22** schools funded by the National Institute of Nursing Research (NINR) to provide high quality research training to prepare the next generation of nursing scientists.

## Fellowship Overview

- Receive individualized guidance from experienced interdisciplinary advisors
- Training and mentoring in biweekly seminars
- A stipend, partial payment of tuition & fees, and health insurance coverage
- Support for travel to scientific meetings and training/research related expenses
- Two years of support, with renewal each year contingent upon satisfactory progress
