Purposes:

Initial Goals (12-2015):

1. Submit at least two abstracts, focused on elements related to psychiatric consultation-liaison nursing practice, for the annual ISPN conference.
2. Develop a mentoring program for those who are new to, interested in, or who are in the process of developing consultation-liaison components within their advanced PMH nursing practice by Dec. 2017.
3. Develop a psychiatric consultation-liaison advanced nursing practice curriculum proposal by Dec. 2018.
4. Submit an article on psychiatric consultation-liaison advanced nursing practice for each issue of the ISPN *Connections* newsletter.

Meetings:

One meeting at the ISPN conference each year with two whole-group conference calls per year for networking and project development. Most work and communication would be through email or the ISPN list serve, but some small-group conference calls may be required to accomplish project goals. Plans and anticipated calls would be submitted in advance for funding approval.
